Serves individuals of all ages. MILC's Personal Assistant Services (PAS) program provides assistance to older adults and other individuals in the comfort of the individual home. Help can range from personal needs to simple household tasks. This program is available to individuals receiving Medical Assistance or through private pay.

MILC allows you to hire someone you trust and know such as a family member or friend to provide those services for you (some restrictions apply). MILC will train and employ that person allowing him/her to be paid for their time. If you do not know someone, MILC will hire an assistant for you.
