

Wisconsin Well Woman Program

The program provides preventative screening services for breast and cervical cancer at *no cost* to you if:

- 1. You are a woman between the ages of 35-64, women 35-44 can receive only cervical screening, a mammogram ONLY if there is a breast abnormality indicated.**
- 2. You do not have health insurance or your insurance does not cover screening exams.**
- 3. Your income meets our guidelines (250% of Federal Poverty Level).**

The Well Woman Program pays for ONLY limited breast and cervical cancer procedures.

The Well Woman Program does not pay for treatment of conditions other than breast or cervical cancer, even if those conditions were found during a Well Woman check up.

However, if treatment is needed for breast or cervical cancer, Well Woman Medicaid is available for those women who are enrolled to cover any costs related to treatment.
