

Chapter 92 of Wisconsin Statutes requires counties in Wisconsin to develop Land and Water Resource Management (LWRM) plans. Wood County completed its LWRM plan in 2000. A mandated revision of the plan must be completed in 2007. In revising this plan, it is the goal of the Wood County Land Conservation Committee to involve landowners, concerned citizens, local government officials, state and federal officials, interest groups, and educators to assess natural resource concerns, identify and prioritize the concerns, set goals and define action steps needed to accomplish them.
