WHEREAS, Sheriff Becker has requested a political leave of absence for his first term, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE WOOD COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY RESOLVES to, grant Wood County Sheriff Shawn Becker a political leave of absence for this present term of office, per county policy. Should Sheriff Becker choose not to seek re-election, or be defeated in the next Sheriff's election, the County Board of Supervisors pledges their support of Sheriff Becker returning to the department in any capacity where there may be a vacancy at that time. In addition to the support pledged in this resolution, a return to the Sheriff's Department in this capacity would also need the support of the current Wood County Sheriff.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution is not intended to supersede the provisions of any labor agreement then in effect or the civil service ordinance.
