INTENT & SYNOPSIS: To have the county board go on record in support of funding proposed security upgrades to the courthouse.

FISCAL NOTE: See attached. Step 1 is \$50,000 and is in the 2018 budget. Step 2 is \$300,000 and Step 3 is \$340,000 and these would likely be budgeted for 2019 and maybe extending into 2020. The recurring costs are estimated at \$250,000 annually and would commence once the metal detectors and x-ray machine are installed at the main entrance to the courthouse.

WHEREAS, the Courthouse Security Committee (CSC) has been meeting to discuss what steps are appropriate for courthouse security in light of an audit that was done by the US Marshalls Service, and

WHEREAS, Judge Nicholas Brazeau, Jr., and Maintenance Supervisor Reuben Van Tassel have reported to the Judicial and Legislative Committee (J & L Committee) the recommendations of the CSC for courthouse security upgrades and after discussion the J & L Committee has determined it is appropriate for the county board to adopt and implement those recommendations; a copy of which are attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, Step 1 of the courthouse security upgrades has been budgeted and is being implemented during 2018 but the J & L Committee feels it is necessary for the county board itself to make the courthouse security a financial priority of the county and to that end present this resolution to the board to do so, thereby giving direction to the J & L

Committee and the Executive Committee with respect to the 2019 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE WOOD COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY RESOLVES to go on record in supporting the implementation of the Wood County Courthouse Security Upgrades as set forth on the attached documents.
