Health Alert: Pertussis July 17, 2017

Please distribute to all appropriate personnel in your organization Initial information about this alert:

• Health issue of concern

*Potential outbreak: Person-to-person *Communicable Disease: Pertussis

Location

*School

*General Community – initially cases were in the Marshfield area but are now spreading to the outlying communities of Pittsville and Auburndale

Clinical information

*Number affected: 18 confirmed, probable and suspect cases *Number who could potentially be affected: Community Wide *Incident onset: April 1, 2017 and still ongoing *Symptoms/case definition: Cough, rhinorrhea, sore throat, vomiting

• Recommended actions

*Increase surveillance

*Collect lab samples/conduct testing, treat with appropriate antibiotic, **isolate** at home until antibiotic is complete

*Notify local public health agency about positive cases and a contact investigation will be initiated

* Ensure immunizations are up-to-date

• Background or Comments

Pertussis remains a health risk to the entire community but most importantly to children <1 year of age, pregnant women in their third trimester and individuals with pre-existing health conditions i.e people who are immunocompromised and people with moderate to severe asthma.
