- 1. Item #1 Call meeting to order. Chairman Allen Breu called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM. The meeting has been properly posted.
- 2. Item #2 Public comments. There were no public comments.

PARKS

4. The Parks Construction Supervisor Report was reviewed (see attached report).

Harold Trickle will be retiring on November 1st. He was the Lead Maintenance Worker at the South Wood County Park location. There will be a posting for the position on Job Net soon.

Chad Schooley mentioned that Sue Potocki is full-time as of September 30, 2013.

6. The Park and Forestry Director Report was reviewed (see attached report).

Chad had talked with a Solarus representative about offering Wi-Fi connection at South Wood County Park. One option was to have South Wood County Park offer Wi-Fi to campers with an additional overnight fee or to have Solarus be the outside vendor and let them take care of any issues that should arise. So far the committee has decided to let Solarus be an outside vendor. However, Chad Schooley will meet with them again to discuss further details.

The Highway Department has completed paving the Red Sands Beach Pavillion Parking lot, and there are just a few finishing touches to do.

The committee has given the okay for Parks to put an 18"x 24" sign on the registration board at Nepco in memory of Joe Schillinger, who was a member of the Consolidated Musky Club.

A water-ski pyramid of 60 people was attempted at Lake Wazeecha, and it seems as though it will be a world record.

Moved by Nelson, seconded by Hokamp to approve the Municipal Dam Grant Resolution and the Recreational Boating Funds Grant Resolution and forward to County Board for their approval. Motion carried unanimously.
